

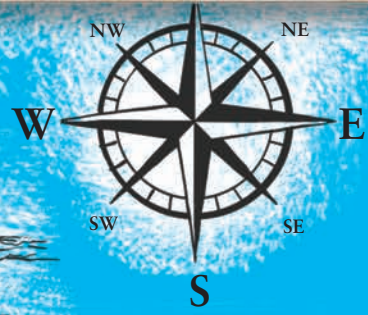

The Shanties on the Shore project features as part of a series of events in 2017 to mark 50 years since Arthur Ransome died and 80 years since his book, "*We Didn't Mean to Go to Sea*", was published.



Other events include walking and cycle trails, geo-caching, photography exhibitions, a drama production, open air cinema, sea shanties and the Script, Sketch and Sail education project.
